



# Are you here today for a well visit, but have another concern you'd like to discuss?

Addressing other concerns will likely trigger  
a copay from your insurance.

## Your Options:

1

### Preventative/Wellness Visit

#### Includes:

- An exam based on your child's age and gender.
- Advice about staying healthy and making healthy choices.
- Identifying risk factors.
- Screening tests based on age, gender, or lifestyle.
- Immunizations based on age.

Annual preventative/wellness visits are covered by many health insurance plans, usually with no out-of-pocket costs for you.

### Problem Sick/Visit

#### Includes:

- Discussion of any new health problem, illness, or injury.
- Management of ongoing health concerns, and/or medications (including refills such as asthma, ADHD, anxiety, depression, etc.)
- Health insurance treats each of these visits as a single office visit with varying coverage.

Your insurance provider may pass some or all of the cost on to you, depending on whether you have a copay, coinsurance, or deductible.

### Combine Your Visit

You may be able to combine your preventative/wellness visit with a problem/sick visit. If you are here for a check-up and would like to discuss concerns not covered under preventative care, you may have the option to do so. Please be aware **SEPARATE CHARGES MAY APPLY**

Appropriate coding and payer guidelines require us to bill services for preventative care and problem visits separately. The problem visit may apply to your copay/deductible as usual.
